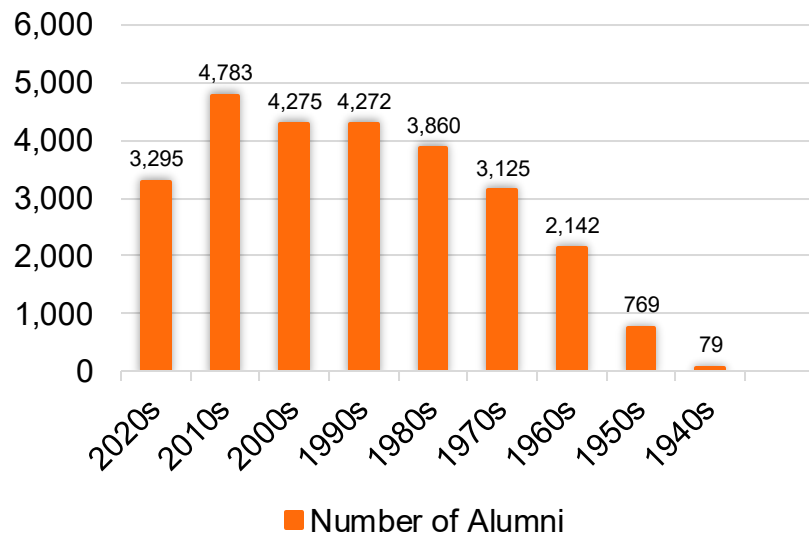

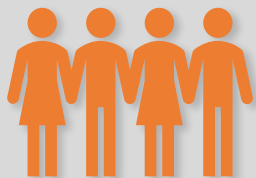


Alumni Weekend and Reunions 2024

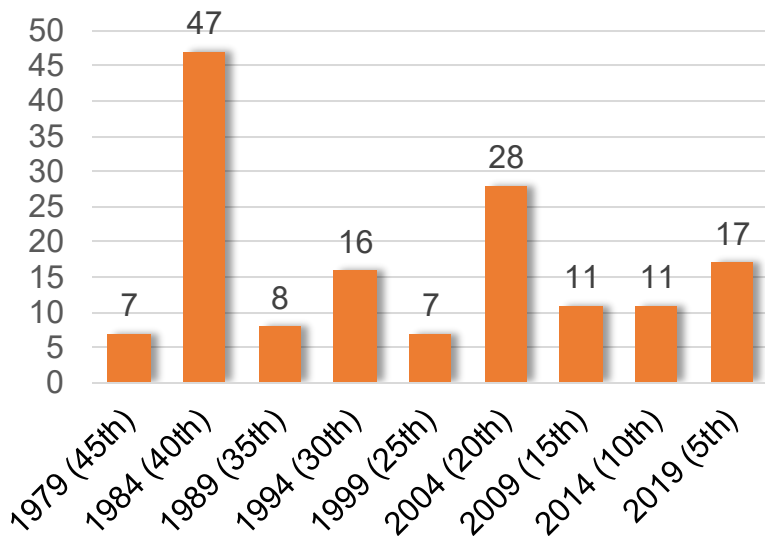

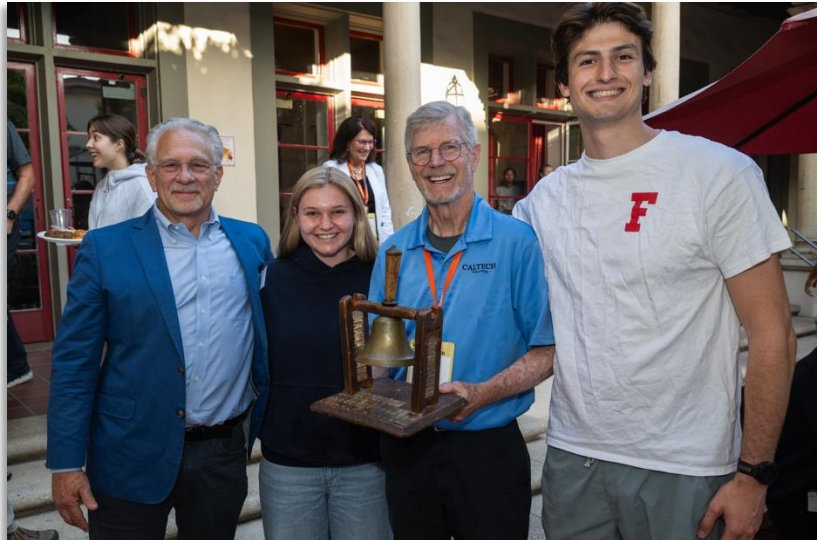

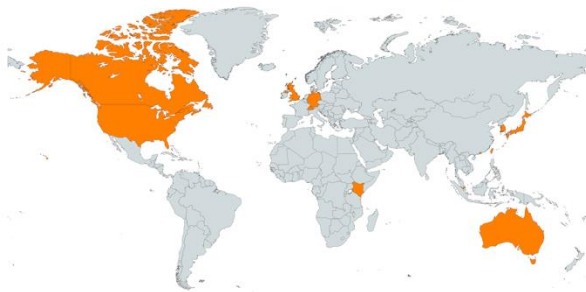

FY25 Engagement:

- Approximately 150 attendees across 8 completed standalone events
- 31 monthly events supported



Techer Professional Network & Mentorship

Techer Professional Network

Caltech's online platform where alumni, students, and postdocs connect for career advice and opportunities.

- 1,235 users, 460 connections made, 4,117 messages exchanged

CALE Alumni Mentorship Program (CAMP)

Pairs alumni with students and postdocs for structured, one-on-one mentoring.

- **Winter 2024:** 78 active pairs (156 mentors and mentees)
- **Summer 2025:** 73 active pairs (146 mentors and mentees)

- 75 mentors, 169 mentees, 257 attendees at reception
